- (c) *Beauty and the Beast* is the theme song of the Walt Disney animation *Beauty and the Beast*.

- (a) Melody 1 is written in G major. (1 mark)
- (b) Write the letter names and sol-fa names for Melody 1. (8 marks)
- (c) Melody 2 is written in E minor. (1 mark)
- (d) Write the letter names and sol-fa names for Melody 2. (8 marks)
- (e) Which of the above melodies is suitable for describing a sad scene? Why? Explain your reasons by referring to the tonality and rhythm of the music. (5 marks)

Melody 2 is more suitable for showing the sad mood. It is written in minor and consists of long notes mainly, which makes the melody quite slow in tempo and create a sad mood.

- (f) Insert one tempo mark and one dynamics mark at the appropriate place on the score of your choice in Question (e), to exaggerate the sad mood. Explain the reasons of your choice. (6 marks)

The tempo mark I use is *Adagio / Lento / Andante*. (1 mark) The reason for my choice is it shows rather slow speed which can create a sad mood. (2 marks) The dynamics mark I use is *pp / p / mp*. (1 mark) It is because soft in dynamic may easily create sad mood. (2 marks)
